Location: Essex
Budget: £40,000
Installed: July 2021

We were invited by Essex Wildlife Trust to replace the old equipment on site at Thameside Nature Discovery Park. The site is a busy innovative visitor centre built on a former landfill site and the existing equipment had started to rot.

In replacement of the existing equipment we installed a bespoke climbing structure, basket swing and see saw. The see saw and basket swing are exciting dynamic features to the play space and encourage interactive play.

The bespoke climbing structure features a crawl through tunnel, a fireman's pole, raised square platforms, balance beams and a clamber net. The variety of elements on the climbing structure ensure that it is fun and challenging for all ages and abilities.

All of the equipment installed has play chip surfacing surrounding which creates a natural look and feel to the area.
